Safety Instructions

- Always turn off the water supply and electrical connections (if applicable) before performing maintenance or cleaning the shampoo unit.
- All plumbing installation and connections must be performed by a licensed and qualified plumber.
- Do not stand or place weight on the basin, footrest, or armrests.
- Keep children away from the unit; never allow them to sit, play, or operate any moving parts.
- Do not install or use the unit in excessively damp areas or areas prone to flooding, as this may cause malfunction or electrical risk.
- Avoid using the shampoo unit in environments where painting, coating, or chemical fumes are present.
- Only qualified personnel or trained salon staff may operate the unit. Individuals with physical disabilities or limited mobility should not attempt to adjust electric or moving components without supervision.
- If the water hoses, tapware, power cord, or basin fittings are damaged, contact your distributor or a certified technician for repair.
- Ensure no objects, bags, or tools obstruct the reclining motion or leg-rest extension (if applicable).
- All servicing and maintenance must be performed by trained professionals only.








Precautions

- The shampoo unit should be operated only by trained salon personnel familiar with its structure, plumbing, reclining system, and safety functions.
- Read this manual carefully before installation, operation, and adjustment. Keep it for future reference.
- All plumbing installation and water connections must be completed by a licensed and qualified plumber.
- Do not overload or apply single-point pressure to the basin or chair.
- Regularly tighten bolts, basin fittings, tapware connections, and structural screws to prevent loosening or leaks.
- Do not disassemble plumbing, basin tilt mechanisms, or electrical parts without proper authorization. parts without proper authorization.
- If unusual noises, water leaks, electrical issues, or abnormal movement occur, stop using the unit immediately and inspect the issue or contact a technician.
- Only continue usage after the unit has been correctly serviced or repaired.
- For electric shampoo units: ensure the power cord is connected to a properly grounded outlet.
- Observe all warning labels on the product.
- When adjusting the recline or leg rest (manual or electric), ensure the client is seated properly and all body parts are clear of moving sections.
- Avoid continuous motor operation on electric recliners; allow cool-down periods to prevent overheating (follow model-specific timing guidelines).
- Clean stains and water residue immediately using a neutral cleaner after each client to protect the upholstery and prevent wear.




STEP 1 Tilt Mechanism Installation

Install the screws and 4 x rubber grommets to tilt mechanism (F) as shown below.




STEP 2

Use a screwdriver and the spanner (N) provided to install the rubber cover (G) over the tilt mechanism.




STEP 3 Drainer (plug and waste) installation

Apply silicone glue evenly over the threaded section of the drainer (E1). Attach Drainer Accessory (E3) to the top threaded section, followed by Drainer Accessory (E2) on the middle thread, and Drainer Accessory (E4) on the lower thread of the drainer (E1). Once all components are securely fitted, insert the assembled drainer into the basin (B), ensuring the moving part sits correctly in place. Then install the flexible hose (J) to the end of the drainer.






STEP 4

Carefully turn the basin (**B**) upside down and insert the tilt mechanism (**F**) by placing the four rubber grommets into the holes underneath. Ensure it is correctly oriented for the pedestal (**K**), then use the spanner (**N**) to tighten the four bolts, expanding the grommets and securing the mechanism to the basin.



STEP 5

Insert the faucet (**C**) into the basin and slightly loosen the nuts as shown in Figure 1. Position the round gasket (**M**) onto the faucet and then tighten the nuts securely to fix the faucet in place.



STEP 6

Install the Shower Head Hose

Insert the shower hose (**D**) through the basin's upper hose opening, then connect the lower end of the hose to the diverter outlet on the faucet (**C**). Tighten the connection securely by hand and finish with a light turn of a wrench.






STEP 6 Pedestal Installation

Install the basin pedestal (**K**) to the chair body with the pedestal brackets (**L**) as shown below.




STEP 6 Installing the Basin to the Chair

Ensure all four sets of nuts and gaskets are removed from the tilt mechanism (**F**).

Position the basin (**B**) so the screws pass through the holes in the pedestal.

Once aligned, reinstall the gaskets and nuts onto the screws from underneath the tilt mechanism, tightening them securely using the spanner (**N**).

General Care Tips

Maintain a stable temperature:

- Cold can lead to vinyl cracking
- Heat may cause permanent stretching

Keep out of direct sunlight for long periods to prevent fading and damage. Regular housekeeping helps preserve comfort and appearance.



Cleaning Instructions

Remove any colour dye, tint, or chemical spills immediately to minimise the risk of permanent staining

Use a colorfast cloth dampened with lukewarm water and mild, alkaline-free soap

Avoid soaking the material

Wipe off any soap with fresh water and a clean cloth

Dry thoroughly with a soft, dry cloth

Avoid harsh chemicals: Do not use bleach, acetone, ammonia-based cleaners, or abrasive powders, as these can damage the vinyl and basin finish.



Avoid Using These Products

- Hot or boiling water
- Alcohol or hydrocarbon-based cleaners
- Acetone
- Bleach or harsh detergents
- Furniture polish
- Abrasive powders, pastes, or steel wool
- Silicone or petroleum-based products
- Solvent-based or abrasive cleaning agents
